2	(a) Pollutant.—Section 502(6) of the Federal
3	Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1362(6)) is
4	amended—
5	(1) by striking "or (B)" and inserting "(B)";
6	and
7	(2) by inserting before the period at the end the
8	following: "; or (C) any deck runoff from a rec-
9	reational vessel, any engine cooling water, gray
10	water, bilge water effluent from properly functioning
11	recreational marine engines, laundry, shower, and
12	galley sink wastes from a recreational vessel, or any
13	other discharge incidental to the normal operation of
14	a recreational vessel; except that this subparagraph
15	does not apply to rubbish, trash, garbage, or other
16	such materials discharged overboard by a rec-
17	reational vessel".
18	(b) Recreational Vessel.—Such section is further
19	amended by adding at the end the following:
20	"(25) 'recreational vessel' means a vessel—

24	dividual for recreational purposes.".
