Due to social distancing requirements, quantities are limited and **wristbands are available for advance purchase only.** Your wristband will include beer in the tent all three nights. The lawn will be configured with 6 feet between tables, both under the tent and under open skies. In case of rain, bring foul weather gear.

The tent will remain open after dinner while social distancing is observed. Failure to remain seated may result in ejection or the need to close the tent. Please cooperate with volunteers if directed to sit down.

#### **Regatta Registration**

Thursday beginning at 5:00 sailors may pick up race packets and wristbands in the tent.

#### **Daily and Deepwater Awards**

The Committee is working to conduct awards while maintaining social distancing. This will include fixed flags for photos and other items.
