

Officers from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection agency will be at North Cape Yacht Club on Saturday May 15th from 12 - 3 PM to register people for I-68's. I-68 registration facilitates the reentry of people on boats returning from Canada to the U.S.

What you will need:

1. 3 passport style 1" x 1" photos for each person
2. Passport for each person (birth certificates are no longer sufficient)
3. Last year's I-68 form if you have one
4. Your boat's registration or documentation number (it may be useful to have your registration or documentation form)
5. If you have already purchased a 2010 U.S. Customs User Fee decal, it may be useful to bring the decal so that the decal number can be recorded with your I-68.

If you plan to attend, please email [Paul Quinlan \(pwq1@comcast.net\)](mailto:pwq1@comcast.net) with the names and dates of birth of those who will be registering no later than Thursday evening, May 13th. This will greatly facilitate the approval process.

Notes:

1. Each person who is 14 years of age or older needing an I-68 must be present. The names and dates of birth of children less than 14 years of age must be listed on one or both of their parents' Form I-68.
2. There is a \$16 fee for individuals and a \$32 for families.
3. Payment can be made by personal check or cash for the exact amount.
4. The Customs User Fee decal is for 30 foot boats and larger and cannot be purchased at the I-68 Registration event .

6. An alternative to purchasing the decal is to just pay the \$27.50 fee by credit card the first time you return to the U.S. and report in by telephone.
